

Dear colleagues,

To answer inquiries from you regarding SCOPUS indexing, the followings are short descriptions on SCOPUS indexing of Journal of Mechanical Engineering (JMechE).

Scopus is a bibliographic database containing abstracts and citations for academic journal articles. Scopus is owned by Elsevier. However, to avoid conflict of interest in the choice of journals (since Elsevier is also a publisher of many international journals), an independent and international Scopus Content Selection and Advisory Board was established.

**Elsevier has submitted a subscription to the Journal of Mechanical Engineering (JMechE) which also a confirmation that JMechE is indexed by SCOPUS.** However, we understand that indexing can take quite a while, and in fact SCOPUS is still in the process of indexing JMechE articles of 2016. Thus, at this moment, SCOPUS coverage of JMechE only appears until 2015.

I hereby confirm based on our communication with SCOPUS-Elsevier that ***currently JMechE is being indexed by SCOPUS until 2017 and SCOPUS is still in the process of indexing of JMechE articles in 2016.***

Hopefully, this information will enlighten the status of indexing of JMechE by SCOPUS.
